Dear Parents,

Thank you for returning your permission slips and payment promptly. We hope you have received the 'kit list' sent out earlier in the week but we have included a copy in case you have mislaid it.

We have noticed many children do not have suitable clothes to participate in PE lessons. Children must have a change of clothes for PE that is suitable for wearing outside. This should include; long trousers (for cold days), shorts, t-shirt, jumper, trainers/plimsolls and socks. We are sending PE kits home so you can double check that your child has a complete kit with suitably fitting clothes and shoes. Please note, there will be no PE next week due to our school field trip.

Area	What we have learnt	Ideas to support at home
Topic	We have been discussing recycling! We have looked at different waste materials, such as cardboard, plastic, glass, paper, garden waste etc. and we have sorted them into the correct bins. Ask your child to help you with the recycling on bin day.	
Phonics	We have continued with Phase 4 of letters and sounds. This week we have been learning to read and write CCVC words (e.g. step, twin, crash) and have learnt the new tricky words; have, like, some, come.	
Literacy	We have been using our phonics to write lists. We have made lists of things we can recycle in the blue bin and the green bin. We have also made lists of the farm animals we hope to see on our trip to Wimpole.	
Maths	We have focused on learning our teen numbers and partitioning them into tens and units. For example 17 is 10 and 7. Practise recognising, ordering and writing numbers to 20.	

Show and Tell

Show and Tell during the first week back will be the **Rainbow Fish** group. The object will need to be something linked to our topic "Protectors of the Planet" where we are learning about different ways of looking after our garden, community, greater environment and the Earth.
