

Morley Memorial Primary School: Public Consultation,

These proposals have been developed in response to changes to the current accommodation identified as being necessary for the school to:

- meet the statutory education requirements in the Early Years Foundation Stage; and
- deliver high quality education provision suitable for the 21st Century.

This consultation is to seek views and comments on the proposals for refurbishment and redevelopment of Morley Memorial Primary School. These have been identified by the County Council and School as being necessary to support the school in delivering their long-term vision.

This is an informal consultation, seeking the views and comments of local stakeholders, with the aim of refining and strengthening the design proposals to ensure that these deliver the stated vision of the school. The comment and feedback will be considered and, where felt beneficial, the scheme amended prior to the submission of a planning application.

There will be a formal, statutory consultation on the final designs, run by Cambridgeshire County Council, as part of the statutory planning process.

There are three key drivers which have been identified as being necessary to deliver the Governing Body's long-term vision for the school. These are to:

- A provide accommodation for reception pupils that is fit for purpose;
- B bring all children together onto a single site; and
- C improve accommodation throughout the School, delivering a learning environment suitable for a 21st Century education for all pupils.

On order to secure the necessary investment, where possible, and without compromising the Governing Body's vision for the School, the County Council has a need to:

- D respond to growing demand for Early Years education provision, in order to meet the statutory duty to secure sufficient Early Years education provision for 0-5 year olds.

Many options have been considered with respect to these drivers. These options, including the currently preferred option, are described on the display boards. Your comments on the options are welcomed, and feedback forms are provided for this purpose.
